
## **Hello campers**


Everything says R or X. R is reserved, X is not available. We are going for the sites that are currently not available (X) but will be made available tomorrow. When available the cells appear with an A.



We want to reserve June 22 to 25 (3 nights).


Click the "5 days" button till you reach our dates.

Use the "Sort: availability, flexible" option.




Come 6:59am or close to 7am. Start smashing this refresh button (seen below in red).

(MAKE SURE YOU ARE LOGGED IN BEFORE YOU GET HERE)



I think it's bad to do a webpage refresh button because is resets the dates and is very slow.

Once the sites are released, the available ones will pop up at the top of the site list with A's in the cells. At this point click the start date and end date (June 22 and 25) then click add to cart. DO THIS AS FAST AS YOU CAN. See example below,
